**Committee Reports:**

a. Finance/Audit – Vitous reported: As of June 1, 2016, Income was \$11,426.46 and Expenses were \$3,544.00 with a Fund Balance of \$44,567.65.

b. Long Range Planning – Kiehle gave an update on the LLA/NMC Lake Studies Internship Plan partner approvals. Dennis Wiand spoke regarding the Long Lake Foundation and recognized John and Joy Tobin for many years of service. addressed Fireworks Ordinance, Crescent Shores Boat Launch and

c. Community Affairs – Zirnhelt introduced the New Long Lake Fire Chief, provided information regarding the Fireworks Ordinance and gave an update on the Crescent Shores Boat Launch. Chief Down gave an update on the Long Lake Fire Department. Karen Rosa, Long Lake Township Supervisor welcomed Chief Down, thanked everyone for the water access slips, provided an update Crescent Shores project and indicated that the Fireworks Application was submitted for July 2.

d. Lake Management – Cartwright indicated that the invasive species program was going hi-tech utilizing a new company, zerogravity for aerial surveying and mapping with drones. Wheaton gave an update on the invasive species treatment process – notices are out. Acquatic Doctors to treat around June 22 (24 sites, 11.3 acres). Lishawa explained the resources on LLA website, that the lake has low calcium levels and that the foam on the lake is naturally occurring and not harmful.

e. Membership/Nominations – Dow indicated progress on new member solicitation. Keihle mentioned the new frosted plastic mugs available to members tonight.

f. Fishing Quality/Loon Management – Motley gave update on loon, muskrat and beaver activity on Long, Mickey and Ruth Lakes. Also provided information on the Master Angler Program.

g. Water Safety – Kraimer introduced Sheriff Tom Bensley who indicated that if you need police assistance call the Marine Patrol #922-2112 and/or Non-Emergency Police #922-4550.

h. Island Maintenance – Kramer indicated that the dock is out on South Island and that the Porta Potties on Long and Fox Islands are clean.
