#### Committee Reports;

Finance Report: Moy reported a fund balance of \$21,200.56, as of July 8, 2020. Questions regarding insurance payments in the budget need further clarification. Lemcool and Kiehle will follow up.

Long Range Planning/Communication and Website: Kiehle presented possible scenarios for non-members to make donations to the Long Lake Association on the website.

Lake Management-Treatment: Schell stated the 2<sup>nd</sup> milfoil treatment would be July 20. Cerny requested that his shoreline be excluded.

Lake Management-Studies: Klein reported that Loon Alert signs have been installed at the Crescent Shores boat launch and at the channel to Mickey Lake. Water samples were collected in Long, Mickey and Ruth Lakes and submitted for testing. He hopes to collect more samples in late summer and fall. Lishawa reported that zebra mussels, which are an invasive species, have been found in Long Lake.

Lake Management- Swimmer's Itch:Dahlstrom reported very few swimmer's itch cases have been reported.

Water Safety: Cerny stated the Sheriff's Dept had no report available. Members voiced concerns regarding aggressive behavior of boaters at the Crescent Shores boat launch over the busy weekends.

Fishing Quality/Loon Management: Motley reported that Walleye fishing has been exceptional. There are three loon chicks on the lake. The Fox Island nest platform has been removed.

Membership/Nominations: Watson reported the newsletter mailing is slightly delayed due to a backlog at the printing service. Suggestions were made to do future mailings electronically, if possible. The position of board president is available.

Community Affairs: Millage brochure from the township has been included in tax statements.

Island Maintenance: Chains on some Long Island picnic tables have been broken and needed to be replaced. Picnic Island dock has been installed.
