- None

New Business:

- Discussed final content for the Annual meeting on August 27, 2022. We will include a short term rental update, etc.
- Discussed providing input to the Long Lake Township regarding the Crescent Shores launch upgrade. For example, recommend implementing a parking fee to fund the launch attendant, drone services to support EWM treatment, etc. The expansion of the parking lot portion of the proposed project is popular. It appears the grant to expand the Crescent Shores launch was denied for this year.
- Next shoreline subcommittee meeting will be conducted on September 8th which is still within the current moratorium timeframe. It is likely there will be another moratorium extension. The new Long Lake Township attorney, Chris Bzdok with the Olson, Bzdok & Howard law firm, believes the final decision on the Windswept Pine Project may take another 12 to 18 months. The appeal process has begun. Mr. Bzdok was hired to specifically focus on the dredging issue.

Committee Reports

- Financial Report: No report.
- Communication/Long Range Planning: No report.
- Lake Management/Treatment: Brent/Dave reported that we have received the invoice and paid for the second milfoil treatment. The ProcellaCOR pilot for Mickey Lake had good results. Did not get full lake drone survey due to availability issue, Zero Gravity only provided treatment day aerial guidance this year. There is future discussion planned for the northwest corner of Long Lake using ProcellaCOR.
- Lake Management/Studies: Len reported that the interns are out every two weeks. His slide presentation will consist of information on the New Zealand mud snail, water testing results, and a colony filter feeder (i.e. 'alien brain'). Presentation will be shorter this year. Len also reported that a study of perchlorate was conducted July 4 and July 5th showing 0.15 micrograms per liter on July 4th and 0.53 after the fireworks. There will be another sample taken in September and Len will report back to Board on results.
- Rick D. reported that the zebra mussels seem to be colonizing. There will be a slide on his findings at the annual meeting.
- Lake Management/Prevention: Mark W. has a tentative date for the fall road cleanup of Saturday, September 24th at 9:00 am. An email will be sent to all Board members with a link to the required safety video.
- Water Safety: There has been no attendant at the boat launch recently. Ian Ferguson, our Sheriff for Long Lake has not been in any communication with the Board. He has only been seen on the lake a few times this year. Will try to contact and get an update before the annual meeting.

- Fishing Quality/Loon Management: Mark C. reported four loon families and five chicks this year. A recent count had 28 loons on the lake earlier in the season, now 19. Received reports of two injured loons. There will be a slide at the annual meeting with contact numbers for issues with loons. There was no lake survey this spring for walleye, but the DNR may conduct a survey in the fall. Seems to be slower fishing than normal with lots of bait fish present. Catching more perch than walleye this summer.
- Membership/Nominations/Recreation/Social: Becki will bring extra ballots to the meeting. We have seen a few more votes online with 15 total thus far.
- Community Affairs: The township has offered their facilities for our Board meetings. We will decide at our September meeting whether to continue with zoom, meet at Boones or at the township.
